**01389490 PASSAIC RIVER DIVERSION AT LITTLE FALLS, NJ**

PASSAIC RIVER BASIN

LOCATION.--Lat 40°53'07", long 74°14'05" referenced to North American Datum of 1983, Wayne Township, Passaic County, NJ, Hydrologic Unit 02030103, above Beatties Dam, 0.7 mi upstream from the gaging station on the Passaic River at Little Falls (01389500).

**SURFACE-WATER RECORDS**

REMARKS.--The Passaic Valley Water Commission diverts water from the Passaic River for municipal supply. Prior to the 2001 water year, figures included those made at Wanaque South pumping station on the Pompton River at Two Bridges (01388982). Negative flows indicate excess water from Wanaque South pumping station (01388982) was returned to the Passaic River at Little Falls (01389500). Occasionally releases from Point View Reservoir (01387959) are included in this total. Records provided by Passaic Valley Water Commission.
