REMARKS.—Diversion from Delaware River by North Penn Water Authority for municipal supply of the Authority and North Wales Water Authority also to Bradshaw Reservoir on the East Branch Perkiomen Creek, tributary to Schuylkill River, to supplement flow to Limerick Power Station.
