**01388981 POMPTON RIVER DIVERSION TO ORADELL RESERVOIR, AT TWO BRIDGES, NJ**

PASSAIC RIVER BASIN

LOCATION.--Lat 40°54'00", long 74°16'15" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Wayne Township, Passaic County, NJ, Hydrologic Unit 02030103, at the Wanaque South pumping station, 750 ft upstream from the Passaic River, and 0.4 mi north of Two Bridges.

**SURFACE-WATER RECORDS**

REMARKS.--United Water New Jersey diverts water to Oradell Reservoir. Due to the hydraulics of the reach, it is possible for the intake to also draw water up from Passaic River, located 750 ft downstream from the intake. Water can also be diverted from Wanaque Reservoir and Ramapo River at Pompton Lakes to Oradell Reservoir in the Hackensack River basin. Figures given herein include diversion from any of the three sources. Prior to water year 1989, diversion was solely from Ramapo River at Pompton Lakes.
