LOCATION.--Lat 40°20'35", long 74°37'51" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, West Windsor Township, Mercer County, NJ, Hydrologic Unit 02030105, at Delaware and Raritan Canal aqueduct over the Millstone River, 1.4 mi southeast of Princeton, 2.0 mi upstream of Carnegie Lake Dam.

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

REMARKS.--Water is transferred from Carnegie Lake (Millstone River) at the aqueduct, to the Delaware and Raritan Canal, 4.1 mi downstream from the gaging station on the Delaware and Raritan Canal at Port Mercer (01460440). Negative discharge indicates flow from Canal to Carnegie Lake. Records provided by New Jersey Water Supply Authority.
