LOCATION.--Lat 41°02'35", long 74°36'27" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Sparta Township, Sussex County, NJ, Hydrologic Unit 02020007, at Morris Lake, and 1.7 mi northwest of Sparta.

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

REMARKS.--Water diverted from Morris Lake, located on an unnamed tributary of Glen Brook, a tributary to the Wallkill River (Hudson River Basin), by the Newton Water and Sewer Utility for municipal supply. After treatment, the water is released into Moores Creek, tributary of Paulins Kill (Delaware River Basin). Records provided by the Delaware River Basin Commission.
