## 01463490 DELAWARE RIVER DIVERSION AT TRENTON, NJ

DELAWARE RIVER BASIN

LOCATION.--Lat 40°13'18", long 74°46'41" referenced to North American Datum of 1983, Trenton City, Mercer County, NJ, Hydrologic Unit 02040105, just upstream of the Calhoun Street Bridge, and upstream from the gaging station on the Delaware River at Trenton (01463500).

### SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

REVISED RECORDS.--WDR NJ-82-2: Station number.

REMARKS.--Diversion by the City of Trenton for municipal supply in Trenton and portions of Ewing, Hamilton, and Lawrence Townships. After treatment, the water being withdrawn is returned to the basin at several locations, only slightly diminished by consumptive uses and losses in transmission.
